- a) <u>Singles Championship</u>, <u>Open Handicap Singles Championship</u> 4 bowls each player, the first to reach 21 shots. In the Singles Handicap Competition, each player starts their score with the number of shots allocated by the Competition Secretary. The winner of the Club Singles Championship will be eligible to enter the County Champion of Champions Competition, Loughborough & District Champion of Champions Competition and the Bowls England National Champion of Champions Competition.
 - The "Handicap" will be decided by the Competition Secretary and the team captain.
- b) <u>Maidens / Novice Singles Championship</u> 4 bowls each player, the first to reach 21 shots. Any Member who has not won an Open, Singles or Handicap Singles Championship on any previous occasion is eligible to enter the Novice / Maidens Singles Championship.
- c) <u>Ladies two wood singles Championship</u> 2 bowls each player, played over 21 ends. In the event of a tie an extra end must be played
- d) <u>Ladies / Mens / Mixed Pairs Championship</u> –4 woods each player, played over 18 ends. In the event of a tie an extra end must be played.

The Ladies, and Men's pairs will be drawn by members of the management committee after receipt of entries.

It is proposed to hold the Mixed pairs competition on Tuesday $16^{\rm th}$ July 2024. A draw for partners will take place on the day.

ALL COMPETITIONS ARE SUBJECT TO SUFFICIENT ENTRIES TO ALLOW A MINIMUM OF SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS TO BE PLAYED.

The draws for each competition will take place after the closing date and the draws will be published in the clubhouse. It is the responsibility of the first named player to contact their opponent and arrange a mutually convenient time for the match within the published timescales on the draws.

Markers are required for all singles matches. Scorecards are available in the clubhouse.

All scorecards should be returned to the competition secretary on completion.
